### Synoptic Evolution and comment.

Thundery low pressure to the south of Brittany is moving north to cross the Channel today. A further complex low to the west of Biscay is moving slowly northeast, with associated fronts expected to affect the Channel this afternoon and overnight. Another showery trough could bring more prolonged showers on Saturday.

### Confidence.

Confidence in the forecast of mainly unsettled weather through the forecast period is high. There is moderate confidence in the rainfall detail over the weekend.
