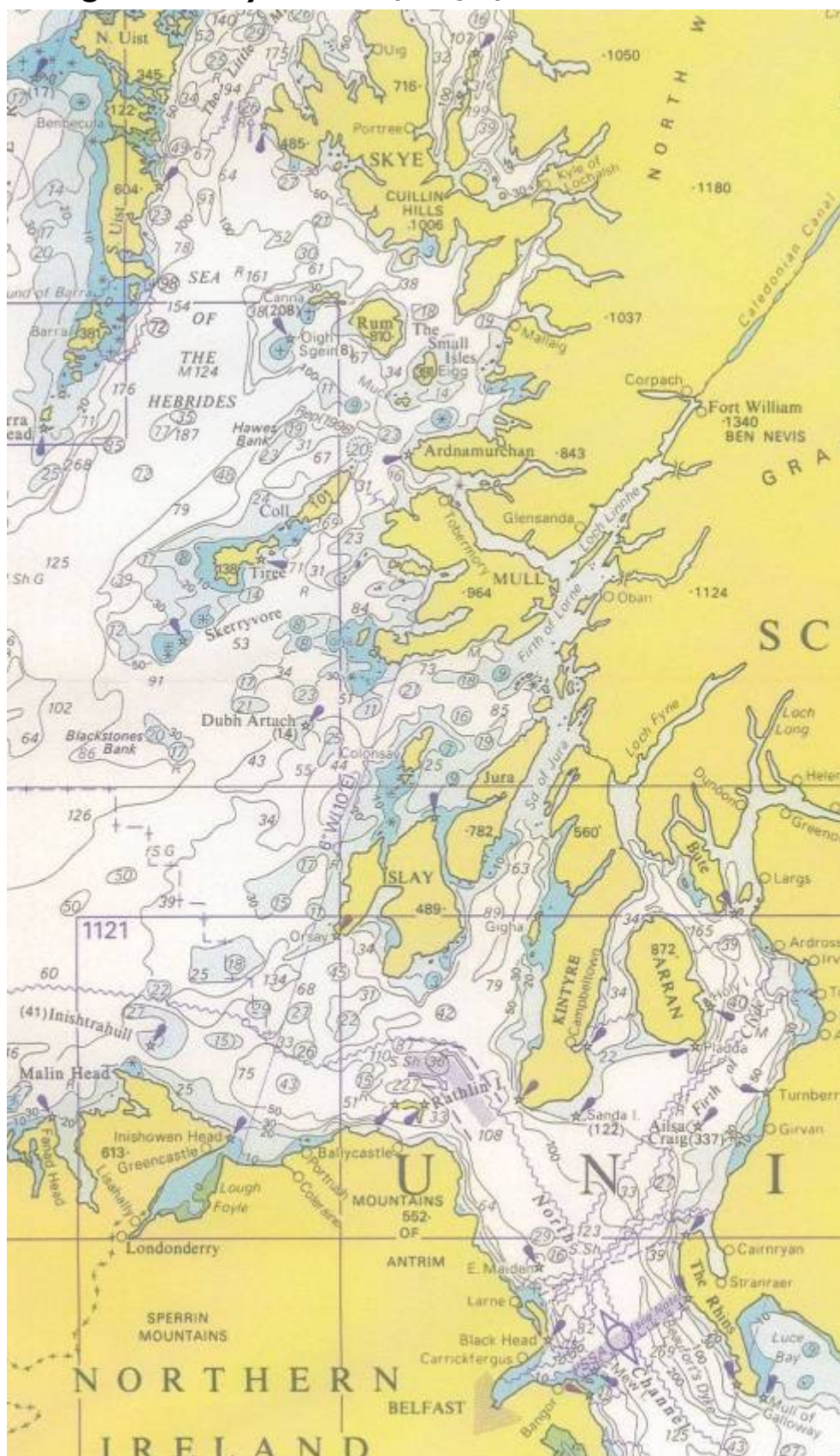


Day 3 (6th August 2007) - Belfast (Bangor) to Lochalsh
