

# CAERNARFON BAR BUOYS - updated 01.06.2012

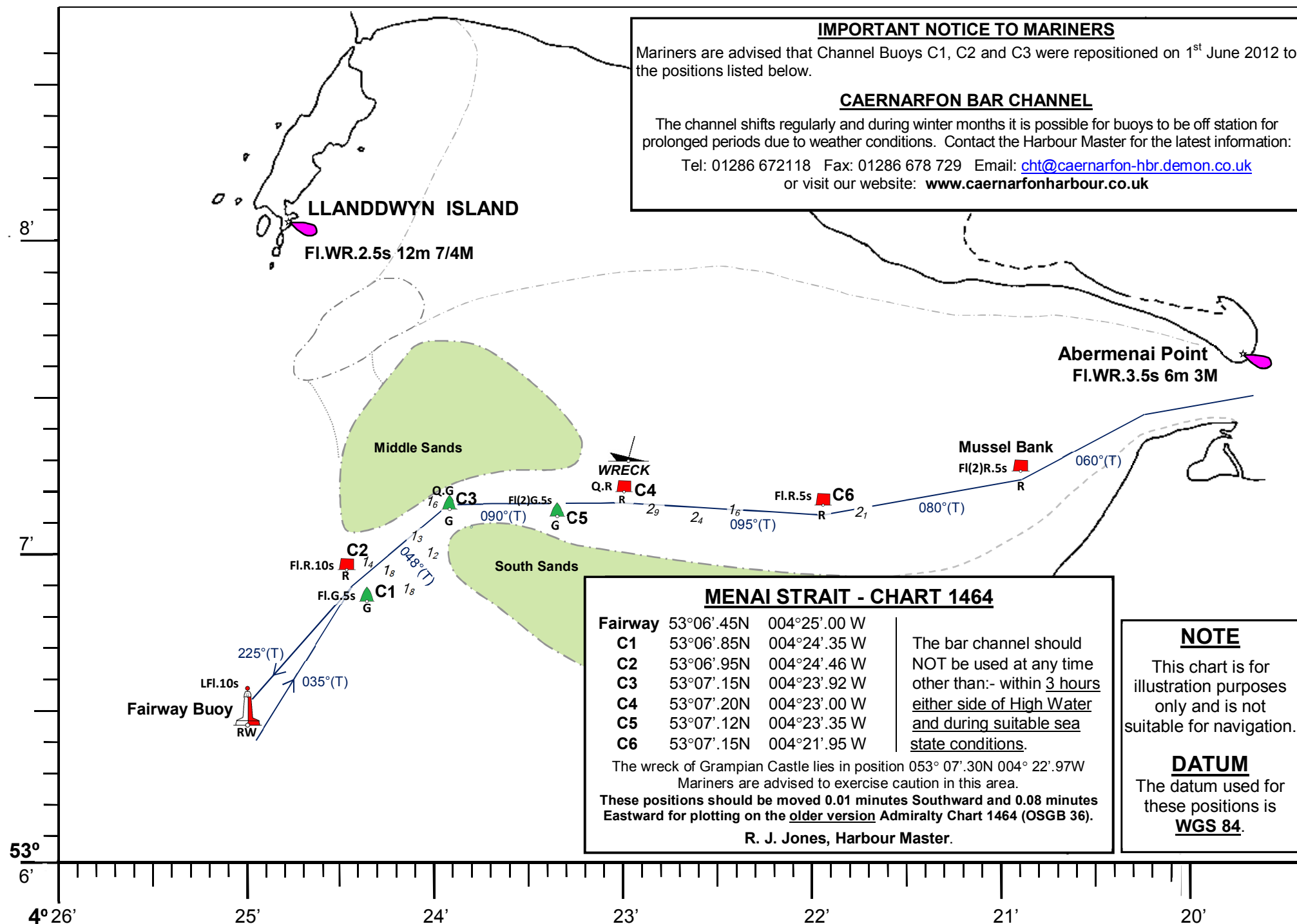
## IMPORTANT NOTICE TO MARINERS

Mariners are advised that Channel Buoys C1, C2 and C3 were repositioned on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2012 to the positions listed below.

## CAERNARFON BAR CHANNEL

Fairway	53°06'.45N	004°25'.00 W
C1	53°06'.85N	004°24'.35 W
C2	53°06'.95N	004°24'.46 W
C3	53°07'.15N	004°23'.92 W
C4	53°07'.20N	004°23'.00 W
C5	53°07'.12N	004°23'.35 W
C6	53°07'.15N	004°21'.95 W

The bar channel should NOT be used at any time other than:- within 3 hours either side of High Water and during suitable sea state conditions.

The wreck of Grampian Castle lies in position 053° 07'.30N 004° 22'.97W  
Mariners are advised to exercise caution in this area.  
These positions should be moved 0.01 minutes Southward and 0.08 minutes Eastward for plotting on the older version Admiralty Chart 1464 (OSGB 36).
